From Hazard Center Trolley Station to San Diego Zoo and Balboa Park

1. Take the Green Line Trolley signed "Old Town."
2. Go three stops to the Old Town Transit Center. Exit the Green Line Trolley on the center platform and walk across the platform to the Blue Line Trolley signed "San Ysidro."
3. Go eight stops to the City College Trolley Station.
4. At the City College Trolley Station take MTS bus route 7 "69th & University via University Ave."
5. For Balboa Park and the museums, get off at the stop on Park Blvd. at Village Place. For the San Diego Zoo get off at the stop on Park Blvd at Zoo Place.

From San Diego Zoo and Balboa Park to Hazard Center Trolley Station

In order to return to the Hazard Center Trolley Station, follow the above instructions in reverse. Take the MTS bus route 7 signed "Downtown." The Blue Line Trolley will be signed "Old Town." The Green Line Trolley will be signed "Santee." The last Green Line Trolley signed "Santee" leaves Old Town at midnight.
